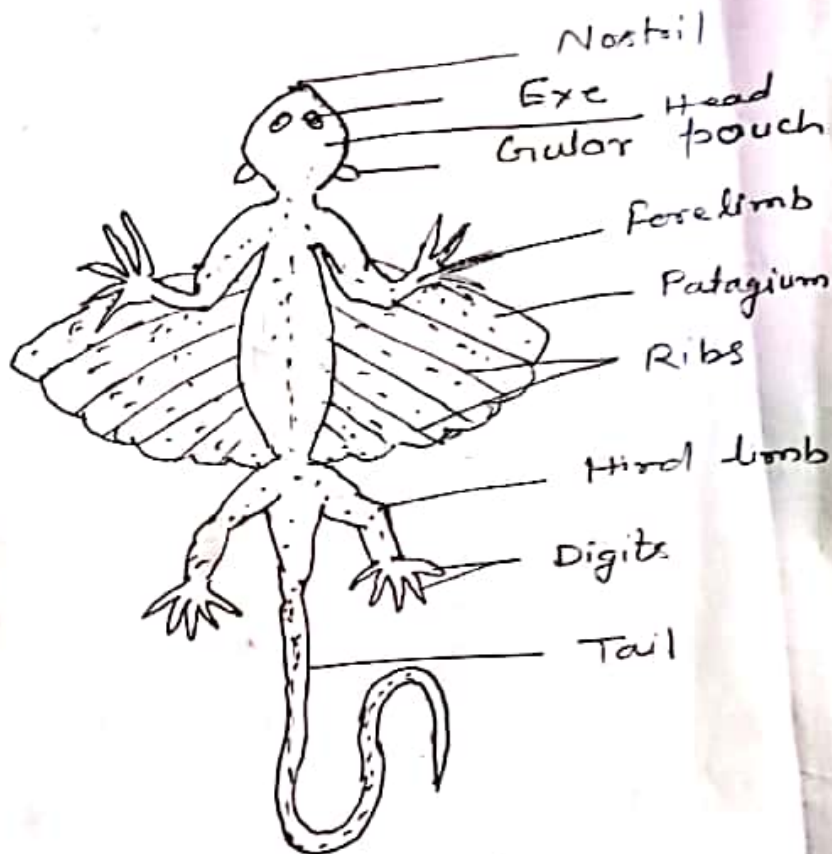

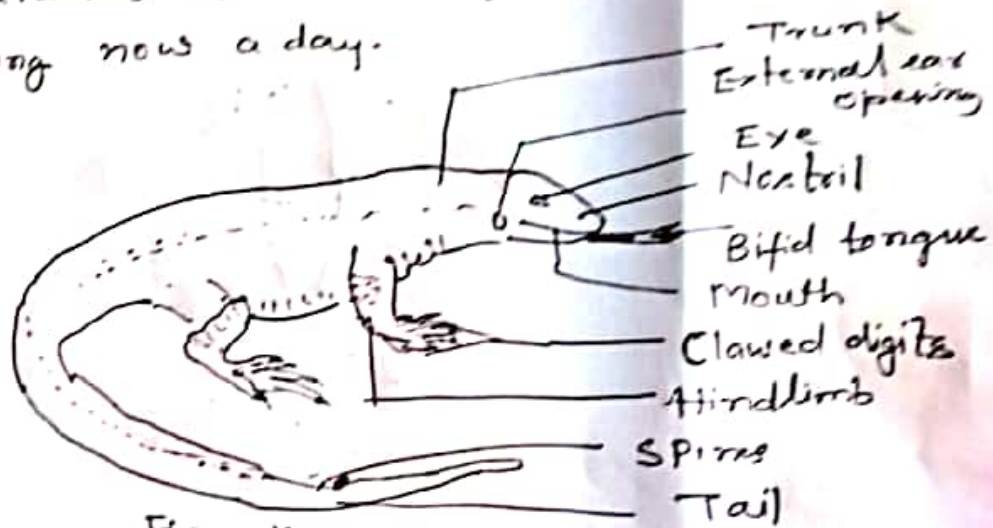
- Draco is the flying lizard found in Assam, Burma and Malaysia.
- It is commonly known as flying dragon.
- Body is 6-9 inch long.
- Grey or bronze in colour.
- Skin extending laterally into pair of wing like membranes or Patagia supported by 5-6 ribs. Patagia help in gliding in air.

- Limbs pentadactyl.
- cellular touch present below the throat gular pouch is large in male.

- Varanus is the largest known lizard living now a day.

- It is commonly known as monitor.
- It is about 2-3 ft long.
- Its lizard like body having yellowish colour spotted with brown spot.
- Its tongue is very much elongated and bifid.
- The tail is elongated and flattened.
- Fore limb and hind limb are well developed.
- Varanus is a nocturnal creature which feed upon turtles, other lizards.
